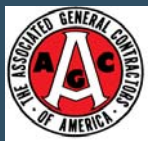

Session 2—BIM Visualization Uses and Spatial Coordination

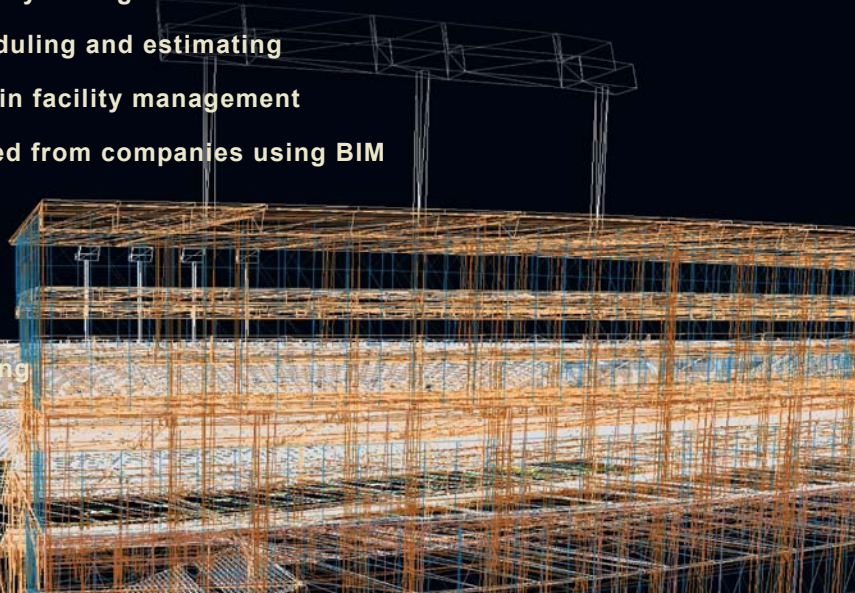
- Recognize the basics of the modeling process and model management protocol
